- Indoor meetings are held at Greyfriars in Ringwood from September until April, on the 2nd and 4th Thursday in the month, at 7.30pm
- We also have an extensive programme of walks.
- Short walks (SW) approximately 1 to 3 miles
- Walk (W) approximately 3 to 4 miles
- Long walks (LW) approximately 4 to 6 miles
- Field study walks (FS) approximately 0 to1 mile
- Social gatherings (G) approximately 0 to 1 mile plus picnic
- Unless otherwise stated well-behaved dogs <u>on a lead at all times</u> are welcome with owners that adhere to the New Forest code and land owner requirements relating to dogs.
- Dogs must be covered by their owners own Third Party Liability Insurance
- In the event of adverse weather, please check with the walk leader
- Keep green, so please arrange to car share where possible
- Those not walking can often meet the walkers for a picnic or a pub lunch

- **Wed 9<sup>th</sup>** (SW) President's post prandial perambulation. Meet in Fordingbridge in the main car park (post code: SP6 1AQ) at 7.15pm for a walk around Fordingbridge exploring the urban botany. We'll finish the stroll in the George Pub.

Thur 31<sup>st</sup> (FS) Alners Gorse with Gerry Lyn. We will meet at Alners Gorse (map ref: ST 735 099) at 10:30am, Alners Gorse is one of the few relics of the heavily wooded landscape that used to make up the medieval Royal Forests of Gillingham and Blackmore, with its mosaic of small herb-rich pastures on heavy clay soils. The site is now owned and managed by Butterfly Conservation. Car parking is limited so please car share where possible.

## August

- Wed 6<sup>th</sup> (SW) Shatterford with Mike and Lnchiz. Meet at the Shatterford Car Park (map ref: SU 340 063) for a gentle walk of about 3 ½ miles. This walk can be wet in places so stout footwear is advised. We will be searching for birds, flowers (including some rarities) and other wildlife as we stroll along well-defined footpaths (for most of the way!) on fairly level ground.
- Thur 14<sup>th</sup> (SW) Milford on Sea with Judy and Sonia. Enjoy a 3 mile walk on level paths with no stiles through a mix of woodland and seafront. Meet at 11.00am in the Hordle Cliff car park on the sea front (map ref: SZ 292 913), there are several car parks along this stretch of road this is the last one on the sea front road travelling east. - Tue 19thStockbridge down with Theresa for chalkhill blue butterfly. Meet at Stockbridge<br/>down car park (map ref: SU 375 346). The car park is 1 mile from Stockbridge on<br/>the B3049 on the right hand side. Meet at 11 0 clock.Bring lunch
