Its nearest town is Ringwood, which lies approximately 4.2 miles south-west from the village. It is in the civil parish of Ellingham, Harbridge and Ibsley. The pub is believed to have got its name from Red Deer shooting that many people would have participated in over past centuries to provide venison for the table. Nowadays culling is strictly controlled by Forestry England for most of the New Forest. We set of walking along Toms Lane which leads out from the pub, it started to rain but fortunately it did not last too long. We took a track across the open forest and circling around passing Toms Farm in the process, then returning back along Toms Lane to the pub, where we had much needed drinks, along with a view of a lovely sunset.
